Invitation to Consultation

Wednesday 24 April 2019, between 3:30pm and 7:30pm

Venue : Main hall, The Misbourne, Misbourne Drive, Great Missenden, Bucks, HP16 0BN

You may be aware that over the last few years there has been an increase in the population of this part of the county. One of the consequences of this increase has been an increasing demand for secondary school places.

Buckinghamshire County Council has expanded a number of schools in the area to allow additional children to be accommodated. It has been identified that The Misbourne school needs an upgrade of its current facilities to meet the demand in the county.

The overall proposal from Buckinghamshire Council is to deliver a one form entry (1FE) expansion for The Misbourne due to the projected increase of student intake by 2020. The scheme will consist of a new larger sports hall with a performance studio and single storey classroom block with associated parking and an external courtyard space. The parking strategy facilitates pick-up and drop-off for the school, with a separate coach entry, enhancing safety across the site for all users.

The teaching block will deliver accommodation to address the needs of the school's 1FE expansion, providing general teaching spaces and offices, alongside ancillary spaces.

To minimise disruption to the Academy, the proposal will be delivered in two phases.

Phase 1: The new sports centre with external MUGA and car parking facilities with pick-up and drop-off bays. The sports centre will be open to the community, enabling use for performances and indoor sports. This phase is due to complete in 2021.

Phase 2: The new single storey teaching block with external courtyard space. This expansion aims to provide necessary accommodation for the Academy 1FE expansion. The delivery date for this element will be determined in agreement with the Local Authority once pupil demand necessitates the need for the additional facilities.

Overall the scheme will be designed to ESFA (Education and Skills Funding Agency) GDB standards.
