



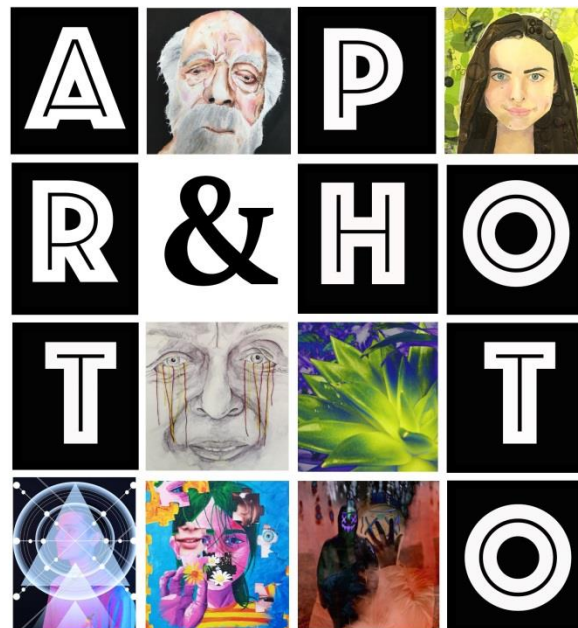

Misbourne Office 365 Launch to Students - Initial testing has been completed and we are now ready to launch our free Microsoft Office 365 accounts to students. Students who have not yet received their account in school from their IT teacher or form tutor can follow these instructions:

- Go to outlook.office365.com
- User name is their current school user name followed by @themisbourne.co.uk (this will be their new email address)
- Password is their current school password
- This should open up their new email account; from here, click on the 'App Launcher' in the top left hand corner to gain free access to the latest online versions of Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, Calendar and OneDrive.
- Any students encountering problems should speak to their IT teacher or their form tutor who will be able to put in an IT ticket to the technician to resolve the problem.
- Our aim is that by autumn 2019 all students will be fluently using their accounts and the longer-term vision includes teachers and students collaborating innovatively on teaching and learning, with pilot groups of staff and students working toward this.
